Indigenous Scholarships



The Hale School Foundation Indigenous Scholarship programme was established in 1997. Its purpose is to offer secondary boarding and day school educational opportunities to Indigenous students from all parts of Western Australia.

Hale has previously provided scholarships to Indigenous students from the Kimberley, Pilbara, South West and metropolitan area; however most students have been from the Kimberley.

Details of the Scholarship:

Hale School welcomes applications from boys with Indigenous heritage entering Year 7 to Year 10 in 2026.

Scholarships are available for both day boys and boarding students who reside regionally.

All scholarship applicants are interviewed by a representative from Hale School as part of the selection process.

The awarding of a Hale School Foundation Indigenous Scholarship will be determined by:

- completion of application form
- submission of last three school reports and most recent NAPLAN results
- submission of the student's birth certificate
- proof of Indigenous descent
- Indigenous Scholarship test results (this test is conducted as part of the interview process)
